The following information is requested so that we can assist you in the selection of a new pet. The cat's well being is our foremost consideration. The consultation process is designed to help us determine if the adoption is in the cat's best interest, and to assist you finding an animal most compatible with your lifestyle.

The cats available for adoption came here from a variety of sources. All animals are examined upon entry, and their health is routinely monitored while in our care, but there is always a chance that an animal is incubating a disease without showing any clinical signs.

After 5 days, any adopted animals are the sole responsibility of the adopter.

Our adoption fee includes:

1. Spay/neuter
2. First vaccination
3. De-worming
4. Implant of an identify micro-chip
5. Limited Free Vet Check.

In order to be considered as an adopter, you must:

- Be 18 years of age,
- Have identification showing your present address,
- Have the knowledge and consent of your landlord, if you are renting,
- Be willing and able to spend the time and money necessary to provide training, medical treatment and proper care for a cat.
