The consultation process is designed to help us determine if the adoption is in the cat's best interest, and to assist you finding an animal most compatible with your lifestyle.

The cats available for adoption came here from a variety of sources. All animals are examined upon entry, and their health is routinely monitored while in our care, but there is always a chance that an animal is incubating a disease without showing any clinical signs.

$After \ 5 \ days, \ any \ adopted \ animals \ are \ the \ sole \ responsibility \ of \ the \ adopter.$

Our adoption fee includes:

1. Spay/neuter 2. First vaccination 3. De-worming 4. Implant of an identify micro-chip 5. Limited Free Vet Check.

In order to be considered as an adopter, you must:

Be 18 years of age,

Have identification showing your present address,

Have the knowledge and consent of your landlord, if you are renting,

The Hervey Foundation reserves the right to refuse adoption to anyone. There are no refunds for allergies to animals. No one who has a criminal record or

pending charges of animal abuse or abandonment shall be permitted to adopt a cat. No cat will be adopted to prospective owners who mislead or fail to

provide accurate information on the adoption application.
